

to the Corinthians 15:51-57*



I will tell you something that has been secret; that we are not all going to die, but we shall all be changed. This will be instantaneous, in the twinkling of an eye, when the last trumpet sounds. It will sound, and the dead will be raised, imperishable, and we shall be changed as well, because our present perishable nature must put on imperishability and this mortal nature must put on immortality. Dichosos los perseguidos por causa de la justicia, porque el reino de los cielos les pertenece.


Dichosos serán ustedes cuando por mi causa la gente los insulte, los persiga y levante contra ustedes toda clase de calumnias.


(We pray for all who have gathered here to worship in faith; Lord, make us one in your kingdom.)
